## Version 5.4.4.02.2017 Fixed Defects

This section summarizes the defects fixed in EFI Technique version 5.4.4.02.2017 by module, including the corresponding issue number and fix version.

### Calculation Engine, Estimating

Issue: Duplicate carton finishing operations are being added for an estimate.

Resolution: Fixed the finishing creation to stop duplicate operations from being created in the multi input single output to single input operation scenario.

### Calculation Engine, Order Management

Issue: Open size spine width is not being added to the section width when entered.

Resolution: Fixed the width update after the spine width is entered.

### Estimating Maintenance

Issue: In Material Maintenance it is not possible to see all the columns at once, the form cannot be resized, and column width changes are not saved.

Resolution: Form can now be resized so all columns can be seen at once.

Issue: An exception was thrown if you edit the fields of a bindery extra without selecting one from the list first.

Resolution: The edit bindery fields are now hidden if no bindery extra option is selected.

### Inventory Management

Issue: Address name not displaying on Load XML.

Resolution: Depending on which destination type the user selects, the address name now is selected from the correct area.

Issue: Multiple lines display when creating a GI PO.

Resolution: Only chosen lines are now displaying when creating a PO.

Defect | 02715880 | TECHNIQUE-5651 | 5.4.4.02.2017

Issue: Cannot print call-offs when two sub sites have deliveries at same time.

Resolution: Users can now print call-offs.

Defect | 02714334 | TECHNIQUE-5630 | 5.4.4.02.2017

Issue: Opening the Loads form from the Loads Due Out view can be very slow when there are many loads, and the view always re-queries after the form is shut, regardless of whether any changes were made.

Resolution: View will only re-query when changes are many loads, and the view always re-queries after the form is shut, regardless of whether any changes were made.

Defect | 02700886 | TECHNIQUE-6083 | 5.4.4.02.2017

Issue: Company Name not in the BOL XML.

Resolution: Added Company Name to the BOL XML.

Defect | 02688127 | TECHNIQUE-5308 | 5.4.4.02.2017

Issue: When changing the address name on a load in Inventory, the new address is not outputted on the XML.

Resolution: New address now displays correctly on the XML

Defect | 02721484 | TECHNIQUE-6087 | 5.4.4.02.2017

## Inventory Scan

Issue: Users are unable to search paper by a GSM with a decimal.

Resolution: Users are now able to search GSM with a decimal figure.

Defect | 02722527 | TECHNIQUE-6114 | 5.4.4.02.2017

## Invoice Generation

Issue: Get a revenue analysis validation message when converting an invoice to an actual even though the figures look correct.

Resolution: Fix to the revenue checks prior to converting to an actual invoice.

## MIS Console

Issue: Unable to search a job number greater than 10 characters.

Resolution: Users are now able to search for job numbers up to 15 characters.

Defect | 02557735 | TECHNIQUE-5430 | 5.4.4.02.2017

Issue: Unable to view production data in MIS Console.

Resolution: Users are now able to view the schedule for all dates.

Defect | 02709669 | TECHNIQUE-6115 | 5.4.4.02.2017

Issue: Running the Quickpricer form in IE11 is losing quantities when the dimensions are changed.

Resolution: Fixed the Quickpricer form so that a dimension change does not reset the quantities (or other estimate fields that have been set).

## Order Management

Issue: Invalid use of Null when sending JDF with supplied section(s).

Resolution: Excluded supplied sections from JDF as was previously done.

Defect | 02732958 | TECHNIQUE-6173 | 5.4.4.02.2017

Issue: Ganging together sections on a non-planned resource causes a large number of unrelated sections to appear in the group.

Resolution: Ganging is not currently meant to be allowed on non-planned resources. This has now been enforced, so a non planned resource cannot be selected for ganged work.

Defect | 02104806 | TECHNIQUE-3550 | 5.4.4.02.2017

Issue: Special of type delivery receives a run back in Order Management when app setting #9 = 1 (no delivery run-on).

Resolution: If the ancillary is a type of delivery or special delivery, and the app setting #9 is enabled (no delivery run), then the price must remain the same if creating a run back.

Defect | TECHNIQUE-5122 | 5.4.4.02.2017

Issue: Book definition is not created in route sequence order. Additionally the Folio Sequencing function in the book def form is very simple.

Resolution: Added a button to the book def form to re-sequence the book using the folio order from route issue.

Defect | TECHNIQUE-5173 | 5.4.4.02.2017
